



### **Port of Oswego Continues to be Leader in Central New York Grain Export**

Executive Director Jonathan Daniels announced today that the Oswego Port Authority finished the season's first major barge grain movement with the completion of loading of over 3000 tons of corn to two lake barges.

"We have increasingly become a center for bulk grain storage and export at the Port of Oswego. Due to our rail, truck, deep water Port, and experienced staff, including our onsite bulk storage capacity, now a major portion of all Central New York grain moves through the Port," Mr. Daniels remarked.

The Port of Oswego Authority has invested in several new mobile grain conveyor systems, a new track mobile, upgrades to storage facilities and rail improvements to increase the handling abilities of the Port.
