



Port of Oswego Marinas Receive Funding for New Pump-Out Systems

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The Board of Directors of the Port of Oswego Authority has awarded Scriba Electric the contract for furnishing and installing marina sanitary pump-out systems at both the International Marina West and Oswego East Marina. Terrence Hammill, Chairman of the Board said, "Since taking over management of the Port Authority's marinas, we have focused on making significant improvements to these very important public marinas on Lake Ontario. It also is in keeping with our responsibility as a New York State Authority, and our stated mission, that we strive toward the level of excellence represented by these installations."

Funding was obtained through the Clean Vessel Assistance Program (CVAP) Construction grants program, which provides funding for up to 75% for the of this boat stationary systems pump-out project

These grants were received to upgrade and improve the Port of Oswego Marinas' services to boaters. The Oswego East Marina is a major docking point for the Oswego's sports fishing fleet, and is located less than 500 yards from the Oswego Canal's Lock 8 of the New York State Canal system. The new pump-out for the International Marina West is part of a major renovation project.
